To whom it may concern,

On April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2011, the Washington State Voting System Certification Review Board directed the office of the Secretary of State to pursue upgrading commercial, off the shelf products used in voting systems, including operating systems, to current, serviceable products.

Hart InterCivic has updated the operating system on Hart Voting System version 6.2.1 from Windows 2000 to Windows 7. They have also added driver software for a new Canon scanner.

After thorough vendor testing, the office of the Secretary of State partnered with Benton County for a complete test of the system on Windows 7. The report is attached.

This upgrade meets the requirements of WAC 424-335-160 for administrative approval of a voting system modification.
