Online registration transmission error

A deployment of MyVote mailing address improvements on 9/17 caused an error when transmitting the information to county systems. The issue was corrected by 11:20 a.m. on 9/19, and missing records since 9/17 were re-sent by 11:54 a.m. We do not have a way to send MyVote test records from our test server to county systems, but will look at other ways to verify packets are set up properly when MyVote changes are deployed that affect the data sent to counties. We're very sorry about this service interruption.

RoboCalls

Prepare for a few more calls. Win Win Network is making robo-calls to about 10,000 inactive registered voters from around the state. Win Win obtained this list by matching the latest VRDB records available with their own phone list database. Their phone script asks voters to update their address before the deadline and gives the voter the option of pressing 1 to get connected directly to you. They plan to continue these calls throughout the week.
