

## Online registration stats

In 2011, 13% of our new voters used our online voter registration system. In 2012, we saw 21% of our new voters register online. That is likely due to the increased activity in a Presidential Election year. Nonetheless, we expect that percentage to continue to increase as we continue to promote MyVote.

## Confirmation Card question from a county

### A confirmation card is returned with a new name and out of county address, what should I do first?

Change the voter's name before forwarding to the new county. The voter can then be transferred, with the new name, using the confirmation card.



## VRDB

### Voter registration

If you backdate in-person registrations, use the Sunday before the online/mail registration cut-off, and "walk-in" for the registration method/source. See this and more: [VRDB User Group conference call minutes](#).

### Motor Voter

Motor Voter registrations with transmit ID 00MV20130326... have met the deadline, even if their registration date is listed as 3/26/2013. Change the registration date to 3/25/2013. Refer to the [help manual](#) for more info.

### Transfers

Do not transfer any voters that registered after 3/25 from counties that have an April election. The list of counties is posted in VRDB Admin.
