### Purpose & general info

#### Why send this postcard?

The Secretary of State's mission is to ensure accurate, fair, and accessible elections. To help fulfill that mission, we want to provide the opportunity for every eligible citizen to vote in the upcoming election.

#### Why did I get this postcard?

Your name appeared on our list of 160,000 residents who have a WA driver license or ID card, but are not registered to vote.

- **If you want to register**, go online to MyVote (with a valid WA driver license or ID card), or we can send you a paper registration form.
- **If you don't want to register**, you don't have to do anything. Now that we've sent you this notice, you won't receive another mailing unless the address on your driver license or ID card changes.

#### When, how many, and whom?

Postcards mailed mid-September to 160,000 residents who may be eligible but are unregistered. Those who received a postcard have a WA driver license or ID card, but are not found in the statewide voter registration database. Most of these people recently moved or turned 18 years old.

Recipients are urged to register online, or we can send them a paper registration form.

Now that we've sent you this notice, you won't receive another mailing unless the address on your driver license or ID card changes.

#### Cost effectiveness?

Studies here in WA and other states show that postcards such as these can increase voter registration up to 15%.

The postcards cost 23 cents per person to print and mail.

### Possible error

#### Already registered?

If you believe you're already registered to vote, an error in your registration record may have prevented matching your name to the list we received from the Department of Licensing. Sometimes the date of birth is incorrect, or you may have registered using a nick name, initial, or middle name.

- **Let me confirm** your voter registration information is correct to ensure you get your ballot [look them up in the VRDB to identify possible error].

#### Why did you delete my voter registration?

We did not delete the voter registration of those who received this postcard. (See *Already registered?*)

#### There's nobody here by that name.

I'm sorry. Can you please tell me the name and address listed on the postcard?

### Eligibility

#### Is everyone eligible?

We caution all postcard recipients to read the eligibility criteria closely before registering to vote. Unfortunately, there is no national list of citizens to compare our mailing list with.

#### I'm not eligible to vote. Why did you send me this?

I'm sorry this information doesn't apply to you. Unfortunately, there is not a national list of citizens to compare our mailing list with. Thank you for observing the eligibility requirements.

- **To not receive a postcard in the future**, please give me your full name and date of birth as these appear on your WA driver license or ID card.

### General questions

#### I don't have computer access. Can I still register?

We can send you a paper registration form. What is your address? How many forms do you need? (Use the [online form request](#).)

#### Is this addressed to Junior or Senior?

Are either of you registered to vote? If so, please let me confirm your registrations are correct. If not, here's information on how to register.

#### Why are other language printed on this postcard?

Federal law (Voting Rights Act) requires translations for voters in certain areas of the state with high minority populations.
