Chelan County is conducting this Election entirely by mail. **Poll sites will not be open on Election Day.** Read all instructions carefully before voting. Failure to follow these instructions may invalidate your vote.

YOUR VOTING PACKET CONSISTS OF:

1. An Official Ballot
2. A Secrecy Envelope for enclosing the Official Ballot
3. A Mailing Envelope for returning the Secrecy Envelope

INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS:

1. Select your response to a measure or race. You have the right to vote in secret. Do not put your name on this ballot.
2. Locate the appropriate oval on this Ballot and use a black pen to fill in the oval next to your choice.

VOTE LIKE THIS:  *Fill in the oval completely.*

3. If you darken an oval in error, place an X over the error and fill in the correct oval.
4. After you have finished voting, seal this Ballot in the secrecy Envelope. Then seal the Secrecy Envelope in the mailing Envelope.
5. Before mailing, **sign** and **date** the Voter's Oath on the flap of the Mailing Envelope.
6. Mail your Ballot with \$.39 postage. In order for your ballot to be counted it must be postmarked or deposited at a designated site no later than Election Day. Designated deposit sites are: CHELAN COUNTY AUDITOR'S OFFICE 350 Orondo Ave. Level 3, Wenatchee, WA between 9 AM and 5 PM and on Election Day 7 AM and 8 PM.

If your ballot is damaged, destroyed, or lost, a replacement may be obtained at the Chelan County Auditor's office.

REPLACEMENT MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION LEVY**

The Board of Directors of Entiat School District No.127 adopted Resolution No.2-2005/2006, concerning a proposition to finance maintenance and operation expenses. This proposition would authorize the District to meet the educational needs of its students by levying the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's General Fund maintenance and operation expenses:
