**CASCADE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 228

LAKE CHELAN SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 129
BONDS TO ACQUIRE LAND, AND RENOVATE
AND EXPAND SCHOOLS**

The Board of Directors of Lake Chelan School District No. 129 adopted Resolution No. 06-03, concerning a proposition to acquire land, and renovate and expand schools. This proposition would authorize the District to acquire land for a future school site, renovate and expand Community Gym and Lake Chelan High/Middle School, make safety and health improvements to Morgen Owings Elementary School, and relocate maintenance shop to the bus barn site; issue no more than \$9,000,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 15 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 06-03. Those who choose not to vote their mail ballot may come into the Auditor's Office to use the accessible eSlate voting machine. The accessible voting machine will be available starting January 17th during regular office hours and from 7a.m. to 8p.m. on Election Day, February 6th. Identification is required.

For voters who vote their paper ballot, you should take one of the following actions:

1. Mail your ballot using sufficient first-class postage. Make sure it will be postmarked no later than Election Day.
