NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Tuesday, November 6, 2007, there will be held in Chelan County, State of Washington, a General Election. This election is county wide.

Table with 6 columns: Proposed by Initiative Petition, School Districts, Pateros School District, Council - Position 4, Council - Position 6, Public Hospital District No. 2. Each cell contains details for a specific measure or district, including names of candidates and their addresses.

Chelan County is a Vote-by-Mail County. This means every registered voter will receive a ballot in the mail. The only polling place will be located in the Auditor's Office at the courthouse.

Those who choose not to vote their mail ballot may come into the Auditor's Office to use the accessible eSlate voting machine. The accessible voting machine will be available starting October 18th during regular office hours and from 7a.m. to 8p.m. on Election Day, November 6th. Identification is required.

For voters who vote their paper ballot, you should take one of the following actions: 1. Mail your ballot using sufficient first-class postage. Make sure it will be postmarked no later than Election Day. 2. Take your ballot to an Official Drop Off Site which are listed below:

Wenatchee Public Library drop box by library book drop 310 Douglas St. Wenatchee, WA 98801. Chelan City Hall drop box behind building 135 East Johnson Ave. Chelan, WA 98816. Entiat City Hall drop box in parking lot 14070 Kinzel St. Entiat, WA 98822. Leavenworth City Hall drop box in parking lot 700 Hwy 2 Leavenworth, WA 98826.

For your convenience the drop off sites will be available October 18th thru 8:00 pm on Election Day, November 6th.
