This proposition authorizes the District to renew a levy of regular property taxes of up to fifty cents (\$.50) per \$1,000 of assessed property valuation, beginning with taxes payable in 2008 and continuing each year thereafter for six (6) consecutive years. This levy provides funds for the personnel costs, training, facilities, supplies and other related expenses for the emergency room and ambulance services. The accessible voting machine will be available starting August 1st during regular office hours and from 7a.m. to 8p.m. on Election Day, August 21st.
