**ENHANCED 911 SYSTEM SALES AND USE TAX**  
 The Chelan County Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 2009-48 concerning a proposition to fund improvements to the regional E911 emergency public safety communications system. This proposition would impose a 1/10th of 1% sales and use tax (10 cents per \$100.00) for ten years, to be used solely for financing, design, acquisition, construction, equipping, operating, maintaining, remodeling, repairing, reequipping and otherwise improving the E911 system, and is conditioned upon imposition of the same tax in Douglas County. **PROPOSITION REPLACEMENT EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES LEVY**  
 The Commissioners of Public Hospital District No. 2 adopted Resolution No. 440, concerning a proposition to provide funds to partially finance emergency medical care and services. This proposition would authorize the District to impose a replacement levy of regular property taxes of 45 cents or less per thousand dollars of assessed value, beginning with taxes payable in 2010 and continuing each year for 10 years, to provide funds for emergency room care and emergency medical services in the district, including related personnel and training costs, equipment, supplies, vehicles and structures, all as provided in Resolution No. 440.
