NOTIFICATION TO VOTERS: Unless specifically allowed by law, more than one vote for an office or ballot measure will be an over vote and no votes for that office or ballot measure will be counted. If a voter has signed or otherwise identified himself or herself on a ballot, the ballot will not be counted.

WENATCHEE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 246 REPLACEMENT OF EXPIRING EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND OPERATION LEVY

The Board of Directors of Wenatchee School District No. 246 adopted Resolution No. 02-08, concerning a proposition to maintain current educational programs and operation. This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, upon all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's General Fund educational programs and operation expenses:

PATEROS SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 122

PROPOSITION 1

PATEROS SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 122 BONDS FOR HEALTH AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS

The Board of Directors of Pateros School District No. 122 adopted Resolution No. 236, concerning a proposition to finance health and safety improvements. This proposition would authorize the District to make health and safety improvements to Pateros School (including acquire and install a new HVAC system and communication equipment and infrastructure; upgrade lighting, windows, flooring, fire alarm, security, kitchen and water systems; make ADA accessibility improvements; and renovate transportation building); issue no more than \$1,397,550 of general obligation bonds maturing within 15 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 236. Should this proposition be:

Chelan County is a Vote-by-Mail County. This means every registered voter will receive a ballot in the mail. The only polling place will be located in the Auditor's Office at the courthouse. Replacement ballots may be obtained at the Auditor's Office, Level 3, 350 Orondo Ave. Wenatchee, WA 98801.

Those who choose not to vote their mail ballot may come into the Auditor's Office to use the accessible eSlate voting machine. The accessible voting machine will be available starting February 18th from 9:00a.m. to 5:00p.m. and from 7a.m. to 8p.m. on Election Day, March 10th. Identification is required.

For voters who vote their paper ballot, you should take one of the following actions:

- Mail your ballot using sufficient first-class postage. Make sure it will be postmarked no later than Election Day.
