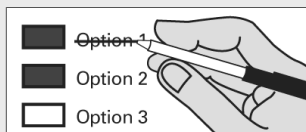

This proposition would authorize the District to remodel and expand Lincoln Elementary School, construct and equip a new Washington Elementary School, remodel Special Education/Early Childhood Learning Center, make safety improvements and remodel gymnasium at Pioneer Middle School and make safety improvements at Mission View Elementary School; issue no more than \$66,500,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 07-13.
