OLYMPIC MEDICAL CENTER
PROPERTY TAX LEVY

The Commission of Public Hospital District No. 2 adopted Resolution No. 416 concerning a proposition to increase its regular property tax levy. If approved, this proposition would authorize the District to increase its regular property levy rate from its current level to a rate of 44 cents per \$1,000 of assessed value for collection in 2009, which amount will be used for computing legal limits on levies in subsequent years, to provide funding for emergency, hospital and other health care services and facilities for the benefit of District residents. ELECTION OF POLITICAL PARTY PRECINCT COMMITTEE OFFICER

Precinct committee Officer is a position in each major political party. For this office only: If you consider yourself a Democrat or Republican, you may vote for a candidate of that party.

Ballots for this election were mailed to all qualified voters on July 30th. Returned ballots must be postmarked or placed in a ballot drop box by August 19th.

- Postage is required on all ballots returned by mail. If you are mailing your ballot on Election Day, be sure to check the postmark cut off time at your Post Office. Ballots bearing postmarks after August 19th will be considered late, and will not be accepted.
- All drop boxes are available 24 hours a day. On Election Day ballots will be accepted in the drop boxes until 8:00 pm. Drop boxes are located at the following sites:
 - ◆ Sequim Licensing Agent 1001 E. Washington St. Ste.5, Sequim, WA
 - ◆ Forks District Court 502 E. Division St., Forks, WA
 - ◆ Clallam County Courthouse 223 E. 4th St., Port Angeles, WA
(In the circular drive)
- A voting device to assist voters who are disabled is available for use in the County Auditor's Office beginning on July 30th. The front entrance to the County Courthouse is handicapped accessible.
- If any voter has not received their ballot, or needs a replacement ballot, they may contact the Auditor's Office at 360.417.2221 or Toll Free 1.866.433.VOTE, or they may come to the Auditor's Office at 233 E. 4th St., Port Angeles, WA 98362. An additional drop box is also available in the office during business hours.
 - Normal office hours are 8:30am – 4:30pm.
 - Election Day office hours are 7:00am – 8:00pm.
