The legislature passed Engrossed Second Substitute Senate Bill 5688 concerning rights and responsibilities of state-registered domestic partners and voters have filed a sufficient referendum petition on this bill. **Sales and Use Tax Levy For Transportation Improvement Plan**

The Governing Board of the Transportation Benefit District of the City of Sequim, Washington, adopted Resolution No. R-2009-10 concerning a sales and use tax to finance transportation improvements. This proposition would authorize a sales and use tax of two-tenths of one percent (0.2%) to be collected within the District from all taxable retail sales in accordance with RCW 82.14.0455 for a term of ten years for the purpose of paying or financing a portion of the costs of transportation improvement projects, sidewalk and street repair and improvements, and model connectivity projects identified

in the City of Sequim Transportation Improvement Plan and in Resolution No. R-2009-10. Should this proposition be approved?

Ballots for this election were mailed to all qualified voters on October 14<sup>th</sup>. Returned ballots must be postmarked or placed in a ballot drop box by November 3<sup>rd</sup>.

- Postage is required on all ballots returned by mail. If you are mailing your ballot on Election Day, be sure to check the postmark cut off time at your Post Office. Ballots bearing postmarks after November 3<sup>rd</sup> will be considered late, and will not be accepted.

- All drop boxes are available 24 hours a day. On Election Day ballots will be accepted in the drop boxes until 8:00 pm. Drop boxes are located at the following sites:

- A voting device to assist voters who are disabled is available for use in the County Auditor's Office beginning on October 14<sup>th</sup>. The front entrance to the County Courthouse is handicapped accessible.

  - Election Day office hours are 7:00am – 8:00pm.
