NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the qualified voters of Clallam County, State of Washington, Fire Protection District No. 4, that there shall be a special vote-by-mail election to be held on February 9, 2010. The purpose of this election is to approve and adopt or to reject the proposition as listed below:

PROPOSITION NO. 1  
Fire Protection District No. 4  
Proposition Authorizing Restoration of Property Tax Levy

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire Protection District No. 4, Joyce, Washington, adopted Resolution No. 13:2009 concerning the financing of fire protection equipment, equipment maintenance and operations. If passed, this proposition would authorize the District to restore its 2010 regular property tax levy rate to an amount not to exceed \$0.76 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation for collection in 2011. The dollar amount of this levy would then be used to establish a new dollar limit under RCW 84.55.050 on the District's subsequent regular property tax levies. Should this proposition be approved?

Ballots for this election were mailed to all qualified voters on January 20<sup>th</sup>. Returned ballots must be postmarked or placed in a ballot drop box by February 9<sup>th</sup>.

- Postage is required on all ballots returned by mail. If you are mailing your ballot on Election Day, be sure to check the postmark cut off time at your Post Office. Ballots bearing postmarks after February 9<sup>th</sup> will be considered late, and will not be accepted.
- All drop boxes are available 24 hours a day. On Election Day ballots will be accepted in the drop boxes until 8:00 pm. Drop boxes are located at the following sites:
