To provide revenues necessary to meet the maintenance and operation expenses of the District, this proposition would allow the district to restore its regular property tax levy to \$1.50 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation for collection in 2008, and authorize setting the limit factor at 103 percent for each of the five succeeding years, provided that the regular property tax rate shall not exceed \$1.50 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation.
