### How to vote




Use blue or black ink pen.

## Emergency Medical Service District 1 Proposition 1

Emergency Medical Program Excess Levy

The Board of County Commissioners of Cowlitz County, Washington adopted Resolution No. 14-001, referring to the voters a proposition to allow the electors of Cowlitz County Emergency Medical Service District No. 1 to authorize a one-year excess levy to be made in 2014 for collection in 2015 in the total amount of \$247,387, at an approximate tax rate of \$1.50 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation, with the proceeds of such excess levy to be used for maintenance, operation and staff salaries for the North Country Emergency Medical Service for an estimated three (3) year period.
