Only voters residing in the Castle Rock School District will receive a third Nonpartisan (NP) ballot. <b>You may vote only one ballot.</b> </p> <p> <b>THIS IS THE REPUBLICAN PARTY BALLOT.</b> By selecting the Republican Party oath on the envelope and this ballot, you have decided to vote in the Republican Presidential Primary. <p>The Board of Directors of Castle Rock School District No. 401 adopted Resolution No. 2007-83, concerning a proposition to finance maintenance and operation expenses.
