

**NOTICE OF PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION  
FERRY COUNTY, WASHINGTON  
TUESDAY, May 24, 2016**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a Presidential Primary Election will be held in the State of Washington, County of Ferry, on Tuesday, the 24<sup>TH</sup> day of May 2016. That in compliance with the provisions of R.C.W. 29A.08.140, Voter Registration books will be closed to original registrations and transfers from April 25, 2016 through May 24, 2016, both dates inclusive, for the purpose of holding the Presidential Primary Election on May 24, 2016. The amendment to R.C.W. 29A.08.140, states after the closing of the Voters Registration books, you may still register to vote **AT THE AUDITOR'S OFFICE ONLY** located at 350 E Delaware Ave, at the County Courthouse until 4:00 PM, May 16, 2016 (for new registrations only). Transfer within Washington must be completed 29 days before the Election Day. Registration is possible at all times, but each qualified elector must be registered at least 8 days before voting. In such instance, the record will be placed in suspense by the registration officer until after the Presidential Primary Election has been held. Registration books will be reopened after the Presidential Primary Election held on May 24, 2016. Following is a complete list of candidates to appear on the official ballots for Ferry County with the candidate's mailing address and phone number. The entire county will be vote by mail. Please make sure your ballot is postmarked or returned to the Auditors Office no later than May 24, 2016.

Ballots will be mailed to all registered voters on Thursday, May 5, 2016.

**Important instructions for voting in the Presidential Primary: In this Presidential Primary, the major political parties require voters to pick a party in order to participate. Voters who choose to vote for a Democratic candidate must mark the Democratic Party declaration on the return envelope. Voters who choose to vote for a Republican candidate must mark the Republican Party declaration on the return envelope.**

### **Voting Center**

This is a vote-by-mail Presidential Primary Election so there will not be any polling places. Ballots should be mailed in or dropped off at the Ferry County Courthouse (Auditor's Office) at 350 E Delaware Ave in Republic or at the Republic City Hall (north side of building) at 987 S Clark Ave until 8:00 p.m. May 24, 2016. Accessible voting equipment is located in the Elections Office in the County Courthouse Basement on the right. Please call or come by the Auditors Office if you need to get a replacement ballot.
