PUD Commissioner, District 1 (nonpartisan)
Precinct Committee Officer (partisan)

All filings must be received by the Elections Department by the close of business on May 20. Business hours are from 8:30am – 5:00pm. Online candidate filing opens at 9:00am on Monday, May 16 and closes Friday, May 20 at 4:00pm.
