The Canvassing Board of Franklin County will meet on Thursday, February 21st at 2:00pm to review the Auditor's abstract of votes for validity and direct preparation of the Certificate of Election. The signing of the official certification will begin on Friday, February 22nd, 2019 at 2:00pm. Both meetings will take place at the Franklin County Election Center, located at 116 N 3rd Ave, Pasco. These meetings are open to the public.
