NOTICE OF VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in order to vote in the General election to be held November 8, 2011, a person who is not registered to vote in Washington must submit a registration application by October 10, 2011; or register to vote **in person** at the office of the Franklin County Auditor, 1016 N. 4th Avenue in Pasco; Connell City Hall, 104 E Adams in Connell; or the office of the Adams County Auditor, 210 W Broadway, in Ritzville through Monday, October 31, 2011.

Persons registering on or after November 1, 2011 **ARE NOT** eligible to vote in this election.

FURTHER, person who is already registered to vote in Washington may update his or her registration by Friday, October 9, 2011 to be in effect for the General election to be held November 8, 2011. A registered voter who misses the deadline may vote according to his or her previous registration address. (RCW 29A.08.140)

NOTICE IS HERE BY GIVEN that pursuant to RCW 29A.04.220 an ADA compliant and language assistance voting device is available for use at the Franklin County Auditor's Office, 1016 N. 4th Avenue, Pasco, during regular business hours 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday beginning October 19 through November 7, 2011 and on election day, November 8, 2011, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Voter registration assistance is also available by calling (509) 545-3538.

These procedures and deadlines pertain to the General election being held on November 8, 2011.

LOGIC AND ACCURACY TEST

The Franklin County Auditor, pursuant to RCW 29A.12.130, WAC 434-335-300, and WAC 434-335-310 will conduct a logic and accuracy test at 10:00 AM on the 26th day of October, 2011, at the Franklin County Election Center, 116 N 3rd Ave., Pasco, for the purpose of checking ballot tabulating equipment for the General Election in Franklin County, State of Washington, to be held November 8, 2011. The logic and accuracy test is open to the political parties, the press, and the public.

OPEN PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

The Canvassing Board of Franklin County, or its duly authorized representatives pursuant to RCW 29A.60.140, will convene at 9:00 a.m. on the 20th day of October, 2011, at the Franklin County Election Center, 116 N 3rd Ave, Pasco, for the purpose of verifying signatures on ballot envelopes of ballots cast as well as preparing ballots cast for tabulation for the General Election in Franklin County, State of Washington, to be held November 8, 2011.

The Canvassing Board or its representatives will meet regularly between October 20, 2011, and November 29, 2011, or until all properly and timely voted absentee/vote-by-mail ballots have been received and the status of provisional ballots are opened and canvassed, which ever comes first. Each day the meetings will convene at 9:00 a.m. and end at 5:00 p.m. in the above stated location. On November 28 at 1:30 p.m. the Canvassing Board will review the Auditor's abstract of votes for validity, and direct preparation of the Certificate of Election. The signing of the official certification will take place at 1:30 p.m. on November 29, 2011 at the Franklin County Election Center, 116 N 3rd Ave, Pasco, unless no discrepancies were noted at the previous meeting, the certificate will be routed for signature in lieu of a formal meeting.

This meeting of the Canvassing Board is an open, public meeting under applicable provisions of Chapter 42.30 RCW.
