

NOTICE OF ELECTION
PRIMARY ELECTION – Tuesday, August 17, 2010

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a PRIMARY Election to nominate candidates for Federal, Judicial, Legislative, and County offices will be held in Franklin County, State of Washington on Tuesday, August 17, 2010. Said Primary Election shall be conducted entirely by mail ballot in Franklin County.

By July 27, 2010, the Franklin County Auditor mailed a ballot and instructions to each registered voter within all precincts eligible to vote in this election. Ballots must be returned in the mailing envelopes provided and voters must read and sign the affidavit/oath on their mailing envelope. Additionally, ballots must be postmarked no later than August 17, 2010, or delivered to the Franklin County Auditor's Office or Official Ballot Drop Boxes listed below prior to 8:00 p.m. on August 17, 2010. ALL SIGNATURES WILL BE VERIFIED by the County Auditor's Office.

VOTING INTRUCTIONS:

Vote for only one candidate in each race.

To vote: Use a blue or black ink pen to connect the arrow by your choice with **one** single dark line.

If you make a mistake: Draw a line through the entire candidate's name. You then have the option of making another choice if you wish.

To write-in a candidate's name NOT on the ballot: Connect the arrow and write in the name of the candidate in the space provided.

Overvote: More than one vote for an office or ballot measure will be an overvote and no votes for that office or measure will be counted.

READ: Washington has a new election system! In each race for partisan office, the two candidates who receive the most votes in the August Primary advance to the November General Election. Each candidate for partisan office may state a political party that he or she prefers. A candidate's preference does not imply that the candidate is nominated or endorsed by the party, or that the party approves of or associates with that candidate.

Election of Political Party

Precinct Committee Officer

Precinct Committee Officer is a position in each major political party. For this office only: if you consider yourself a Democrat or Republican you may vote for a candidate of that party. For a write-in candidate, include party. (Not all precincts have a filed candidate).

VOTERS PLEASE NOTE:

- This election is being conducted entirely by mail.
- Only voters within the districts participating in the Primary Election will receive a ballot.
- Vote-by-Mail voters may return ballots either by mail or in person.
- Ballots must be returned in the return affidavit envelope, signed by the qualified voter and postmarked no later than Election Day, August 17, 2010, if returned by mail.
- Voters may deposit ballots at the Auditor's Office, 1016 N. 4th Ave, Pasco, Monday - Friday, between 8:30 AM - 5:00 PM until Election Day. On Election Day, August 17, 2010, you may drop off your ballot between 7:00 AM - 8:00 PM.

Two additional Official Ballot Drop Boxes are available. The boxes are open 24 hrs beginning 20 days prior to the election and locked promptly at 8:00 pm. on Election Day. The locations are:

TRAC Facility, 6600 Burden Blvd, Pasco

If you **DID NOT** receive your ballot or if your ballot is damaged, spoiled, or lost, call (509) 545-3538 immediately for a replacement.

REPLACEMENT BALLOTS may only be obtained from the Franklin County Auditor's office, 1016 N 4th Ave., Pasco. Office hours are 8:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. **prior to** Election Day. **On** Election Day the hours are from 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.

The Franklin County Courthouse is also a Designated Accessibility Site for those voters who need assistance due to physical disabilities or language difficulties (Spanish). This site is open Monday through Friday, between 8:30 AM - 5:00 PM until Election Day. On Election Day, August 17, 2010, this site is open from 7:00 AM - 8:00 PM.
