The legislature passed Engrossed Second Substitute Senate Bill 5688 concerning rights and responsibilities of state-registered domestic partners and voters have filed a sufficient referendum petition on this bill. Voters may return ballots either by mail or in person. Ballots must be returned in the return affidavit envelope, signed by the qualified voter and postmarked no later than Election Day, November 3, if returned by mail. Voters may deposit ballots at the Auditor's Office Monday through Friday, between 8:30 AM and 5:00 PM until Election Day. On Election Day, November 3, 2009, you may drop off your ballot between 7:00 AM and 8:00 PM.

Two additional official ballot drop boxes will be available. Ballots may be deposited in the drop boxes up until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, November 3, 2009. The locations of the drop boxes are as follows:

The Franklin County Courthouse is also a Designated Accessibility Site for those voters who need assistance because of physical disabilities or language difficulties. This site is open during normal business hours Monday through Friday, between 8:30 AM and 5:00 Pm until Election Day. On Election Day, November 3, 2009, this site is open from 7:00 AM until 8:00 PM.

The Auditor's Office is the single location where voters may obtain replacement ballots if his or her ballot is destroyed, spoiled, lost or not received by the voter.
