<b>PROPOSITION NO. 1</b> <b>SUBMITTED BY</b> <b>FRANKLIN COUNTY, WASHINGTON</b> <b>COURTHOUSE RESTORATION BONDS</b>	
The Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County adopted Resolution 2001-140, as amended, concerning courthouse improvements, the issuance of bonds and excess tax levies. This ballot proposition, if approved, will authorize the County to: acquire, construct, install improvements to rehabilitate and restore the County Courthouse; equip and furnish County facilities; issue no more than \$10,200,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to pay and retire such bonds, all as provided in Resolution 2001-140. <b>PROPOSITION NO. 1</b> <b>SUBMITTED BY</b> <b>BEN FRANKLIN TRANSIT</b> <b>PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION FUNDING</b>	
Shall the Benton-Franklin Public Transportation Benefit Area be authorized to impose an additional sales and use tax in an amount up to and not to exceed three-tenths (3/10ths) of one percent (1%) within portions of Benton and Franklin Counties, the proceeds of which are to be used solely to fund the operation, maintenance, and capital needs of the Benton-Franklin Public Transportation Benefit Area.
