
How to vote

**Ephrata Proposition No. 1**

The City Council of the City of Ephrata adopted Ordinance No. 14-01 concerning a sales and use tax increase pursuant to RCW 82.14.450. If approved, this proposition would authorize the City to fix and impose additional sales and use tax of 0.1%, split between the City (85%) and Grant County (15%). City proceeds shall be used to hire additional police officers and pay other criminal justice costs. Should this proposition be:
