

Proposition 2

The Board of Directors of Moses Lake School District No. 161 adopted Resolution No. 2014-12, concerning a proposition to relieve overcrowding and improve infrastructure and safety. This proposition would authorize the District to: construct a new high school, modernize Moses Lake High School, and make health, safety, security, educational and athletic improvements to school facilities; issue no more than \$98,000,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 2014-12.
