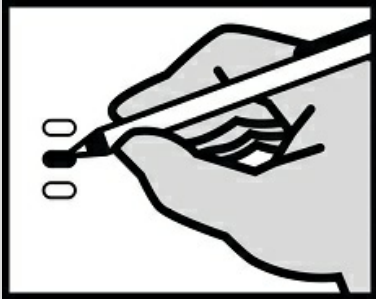


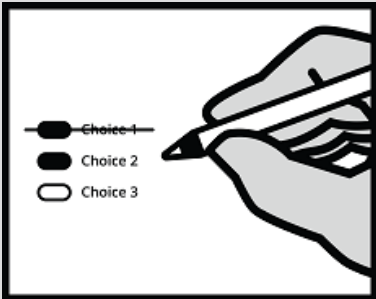

**REPLACEMENT EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND OPERATION LEVY**

The Board of Directors of Quincy School District No. 144-101 adopted Resolution No. 04-19, concerning a proposition to finance educational programs and operation expenses. This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, for educational programs and operation expenses not funded by the State:

2020	\$1.50	\$7,141,484
2021	\$1.50	\$7,998,462
2022	\$1.50	\$8,462,372

Proposition No. 1**

**BONDS TO RENOVATE SCHOOL FACILITIES**

The Board of Directors of Royal School District No. 160 adopted Resolution No. 598, concerning a proposition to improve safety and outdated infrastructure. This proposition would authorize the District to: renovate Royal High School (including making safety enhancements; expanding cafeteria; renovating gymnasium; connecting main building to cafeteria, library and gymnasium to create a single campus entry point); reconstruct and modernize Royal Middle School; construct additional classrooms; expand and renovate Bus Garage; issue no more than \$16,580,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 18 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 598. Should this proposition be:

**REPLACEMENT EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND OPERATION  
LEVY**

The Board of Directors of Ephrata School District No. 165/55J adopted Resolution No. 2018-2019-2, concerning a proposition to finance educational programs and operation expenses. This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, upon all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's educational programs and operation expenses not funded by the State:

**Ephrata School Dist #165  
Proposition No. 2**

**BONDS TO EXPAND AND RENOVATE SCHOOL FACILITIES AND  
IMPROVE SAFETY AND SECURITY**

The Board of Directors of Ephrata School District No. 165/55J adopted Resolution No. 2018-19-3, concerning a proposition to relieve overcrowding and improve safety and infrastructure. This proposition would authorize the District to: construct a classroom addition at Columbia Ridge; make District-wide safety and security improvements; replace roofs at Columbia Ridge, Grant, Middle and High Schools; construct 3 new multipurpose gymnasiums (Columbia Ridge, Grant and Middle School); renovate the Performing Arts Center and gymnasium; issue no more than \$27,893,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 2018-19-3. Should this proposition be:
