**July 9, 2018** – Deadline for mail/online voter registrations, and transfers. Voters currently registered to vote in the State of Washington must update their registration, including changes of address by this date to vote in the Primary Election.

**July 30, 2018** – Persons not registered to vote in Washington must register in person at the County Auditor's Office by this date to vote in this election.
