School Maintenance and Operations Support Levy**

This proposition is submitted by Resolution No. 159 of Satsop School District No. 104 concerning a levy for support of school maintenance and operations. The proposition would authorize the School District to replace an expiring levy and support educational programs, student services, textbooks, maintenance, repair and operations with the following excess taxes on all taxable property within the School District.

**Ocosta School District No. 172
Proposition No. 1
Bonds to Renovate Ocosta Elementary School**

The Board of Directors of Ocosta School District No. 172 adopted Resolution No. 402-2013 concerning a proposition to improve elementary school safety and educational environment. This proposition would authorize the District to renovate Ocosta Elementary School (including constructing a new building to replace the "Round" elementary building that will include a tsunami refuge for students, staff and community; modernizing the existing elementary addition building; increasing parking; and modifying bus, auto and pedestrian circulation); issue no more than \$13,800,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 402-2013.
