- Candidate Filing Period:** Monday, May 13 -- Friday, May 17, 2013
9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Last day to withdraw:** Monday, May 20, 2013
- Where to file:** Island County Auditor's Office - Elections

- On-line Filing:** Online filing will be available through the Island County Auditor's website beginning Monday, May 13th at 9:00 a.m. and continue until Friday, May 17th at 4:00 p.m. Candidates will be able to file their candidacy online, as well as pay any filing fees via credit/debit card.
- Election Dates:** Primary – August 6, 2013
General – November 5, 2013

By filing your Declaration of Candidacy, you are declaring that you are aware of the qualifications required to hold the office you are seeking and that you are legally qualified to assume office, if elected.

All information included on the Declaration of Candidacy is **public information** and will be available to the public and press and posted on our website.

Declarations and filing fees for all candidates must be **received** by the Auditor's Office no later than Friday, May 17th at 4:00 p.m. (A postmark is not sufficient.)

Any change of position or change of office filed for must be completed prior to Friday, May 17th at 4:00 p.m. You must withdraw in writing and file a new Declaration of Candidacy as well as pay the filing fee for the new position or office. **Filing Fees are not refundable.**

Filing will close at 4:00 p.m., Friday, May 17th. At 4:00 p.m. the closing announcement will be made and the last person in line will be identified. Online candidate filing will be disabled at 4:00 p.m. on Friday, May 17th.

Lists of candidate filings are available on the Island County Auditor's Website at www.islandcounty.net and selecting "Elections" and "Candidate Filings". Candidates are strongly encouraged to check the website to confirm that their filing information is correct.

Lot drawings to determine ballot order for all positions in which the Island County Auditor is the filing officer will take place on Monday, May 20th.
