Special Election of April 17, 2012  
Report to the Canvassing Board at Certification

1. The equipment used to tabulate the ballots consists of the HART scanner and software. This system is certified for use in Washington State by the Secretary of State. The programming for this election was done by the election department. A logic and accuracy test was performed.
2. All ballots were stored and locked in a secure area, both prior to the election and afterward
3. All absentee ballots were processed according to statute. Experienced staff verified all signatures.
4. All ballots believed eligible for counting have been counted.
5. We encountered no mechanical problems.
6. Results were reviewed for anomalies by Anne LaCour, Chief Deputy Auditor.
7. There were unusual ballots that were brought to the attention of the canvassing board being no signatures, postmarked too late, and mismatched signatures.
8. Ballot count reconciliations were performed.
