**DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY AND OATHS FOR CANVASSING BOARD MEMBERS OR THEIR ALTERNATES: WAC 434-262-015 / RCW 29.62.020**

**TEST DECK:**

Verifies ballots, programming and equipment. An in-house logic and accuracy test was completed on August 20, 2003. The official logic and accuracy test was done on September 5, 2003. Political party observers were invited. RCW 29.62.020.

**BALLOT COUNT:**

Printouts from September 16, 2003 and September 19, 2003 ballot count. This verifies the number of ballots counted matches with the number of persons voting and number of countable ballots. Includes system log.

**Note: Precinct 702:** Returned their ballot box to Central Count without making notation of the seals used to seal the box. Numbers should have been noted on the ballot transmittal sheet as instructed during training and as outlined in their procedures manual (used at the polling place). Workers said they wrote the numbers somewhere but staff was unable to locate them. Staff did a hand count of the actual number of ballots being

*returned, and consulted with an SOS representative that was here as part of our review on our election processes, we reviewed **WAC 434-261-040** which states if no seal exists, or if a discrepancy is noted between the transmittal and the seals, the box is set aside and the Auditor notified. Auditor determined that there was no discrepancy and that the box was sealed for transport and because staff counted the actual number of ballots being returned, it was determined at that time, ballots were O.K. to count.*

**Precinct 503:** *Returned their ballots in the unused ballot bag with the unused ballots in the ballot box. As instructed in training and outlined in their procedures manual, voted ballots are separated from all other ballots, number of ballots recorded on transmittal and properly sealed in ballot box. Ballots were banded separate from unused and properly recorded on the transmittal. O.K. to count.*




