TEST DECK:
Verifies ballots, programming and equipment. An in-house logic and accuracy test was completed on September 1, 2005. The official logic and accuracy test was done on September 13, 2005. Political party observers candidates and the media were invited. RCW 29A.60.160.

BALLOT COUNT:
Printouts from ballot count held September 20, September 23, and September 27, 2005. This verifies the number of ballots counted with the number of persons voting and number of countable ballots. Each time the new ballot tabulator is turned on and used, a system log is generated.

Note: - 2/3's 13,674 of our voters received 3 ballots; 1-Democratic; 1-Republican; and 1-Non-Partisan. The other 1/3 7,454 of our voters received 2 ballots; 1-Democratic and 1-Republican.

ABSENTEE OFFICIAL "IN AND OUT" LISTING:
The number of absentee ballots issued to voters and the number of voted ballots returned to the auditor are reported on the "in and out" listing and the number of absentees ballots tabulated are verified with the "in and out" listing. Also served as a balance sheet for pre-inspection done by

staff. Master ballot list is stored electronically.

LOGS:

Seal Logs: Logs verify that all election related materials remain under dual control at all times.

Ballot Return Sheet: Verifies ballots are accounted for.

Spoiled Ballot Logs and Spoiled Ballots

Ballot Duplication Logs: Can be used as verification that original ballot was duplicated exactly like the voter voted.

Ballots Requested to be Rejected: Any ballot to be rejected and not counted is presented to the Canvassing Board with reason for rejection and the Canvassing Board determines to reject or not. Laws of 2005






