NOTICE OF PRIMARY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Primary will be held in Klickitat County, Washington, August 17, 2010 in all precincts within Klickitat County. The election will be conducted by mail ballot.

Washington has a new primary. You do not have to pick a party. In each race, you may vote for any candidate listed. The two candidates who receive the most votes in the August primary will advance to the November general election.

Each candidate for partisan office may state a political party that he or she prefers. A candidate's preference does not imply that the candidate is nominated or endorsed by the party, or that the party approves of or associates with that candidate.

FORT VANCOUVER REGIONAL LIBRARY DISTRICT PROPOSITION #1 AUTHORIZING PROPERTY TAX LEVY

The Fort Vancouver Regional Library District Board of Trustees adopted resolution 2010-5 concerning a proposition to authorize its regular property tax levy. This proposition would authorize the District to restore its regular property tax levy to the allowable rate of \$0.50 per \$1,000 of assessed value for collection in 2011 to provide continued funding for the Fort Vancouver Regional Library District's normal operation and maintenance. Thereafter, such levy amount would be used for the purpose of computing limitations for subsequent levies as allowed by RCW 84.55. Should this proposition be:

On July 29, 2010, the Klickitat County Auditor mailed each qualified voter within the county a mail ballot, voting instructions, security envelope, and a pre-addressed envelope. Ballots will be counted only if returned in the return affidavit envelope, signed by the qualified voter and either postmarked no later than August 17, 2010, or received by the Klickitat County Auditor, Klickitat County Courthouse, 205 S. Columbus Ave., Room 203, Goldendale, WA or in one of the two drop boxes available 20 days prior to each election until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. The drop boxes are located in parking lots at the following locations: the corner of S. Columbus Ave. and West Court St. in Goldendale, WA (north of the courthouse lawn); the Pioneer Center, 501 N.E. Washington St., White Salmon, WA (south end of the parking lot adjacent to the Post Office).

First class postage is required for returning a voted ballot by mail.

All signatures are subject to verification by the Klickitat County Canvassing Board or its duly authorized representatives.

If a mail ballot is destroyed, spoiled, lost or not received by the voter, replacement ballots may be obtained from the Klickitat County Auditor, Klickitat County Courthouse, Room 203, on or prior to August 17, 2010. On that day such office will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

For disabled persons and the visually impaired or for anyone wishing to vote on the electronic machine, an Accessible Voting Unit is available in the Klickitat County Auditor's Office beginning July 28, 2010 through August 16, 2010 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. with extended hours on August 17, 2010 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Special accommodations will be made for those that request it.
