Proposition Establishing Property Tax Levy for Fire
Protection and Emergency Medical Services

The Board of Klickitat County Fire Protection District No. 3 adopted Resolution No. 2013-09 concerning a proposition to maintain and adequately fund the District's operations, to improve the District's ability to adequately fund capital facilities improvements.

This proposition authorizes the District to establish its regular property tax levy at \$.92 per \$1,000 of assessed value to be assessed in 2014 and collected in 2015. The funds will maintain and improve fire protection and emergency medical service levels. The maximum allowable levy in 2014 shall serve as the base for subsequent levy limitations as provided by chapter 84.55 RCW.


