

**NOTICE OF KLICKITAT COUNTY SPECIAL ELECTION  
TUESDAY, April 26, 2011**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Special Election will be held in Klickitat County, State of Washington, April 26, 2011 in all precincts within Hospital District No. 2, Prosser Consolidated School District No. 116-219 and Goldendale School District No. 404. The election will be conducted by mail ballot.

**Hospital District No. 2**

**Proposition No. 1**

**Levy Lid Lift**

The Commission has adopted Resolution No. 459 concerning an increase in the District's regular property tax levy.

If approved, this proposition would provide funding for the operation, development and expansion of the District's health care facilities and services including the funding of an electronic medical records system. It authorizes a maximum regular property levy rate in 2012 of \$0.35/\$1,000 assessed value (which is \$0.07 greater than the 2011 levy rate). The 2012 levy amount will be used to calculate subsequent levy limits in subsequent years.

**PROSSER SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 116-219**

**PROPOSITION 1**

**BONDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW HIGH SCHOOL**

The Board of Directors of Prosser Consolidated School District No. 116-219 adopted Resolution No. 01-11 concerning a proposition to finance construction of a new high school. This proposition would authorize the District to construct and equip a new high school on a site owned by the District adjacent to Art Fiker Stadium to replace Prosser High School; issue no more than \$38,950,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 01-11. **GOLDENDALE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 404**  
**PROPOSITION NO. 1**  
**GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS - \$32,000,000**

The Board of Directors of Goldendale School District No. 404 adopted Resolution #10-11-04 concerning this proposition for bonds. The proposition authorizes the District to construct a new high school to replace and/or renovate Goldendale High School, renovate Goldendale Middle School, and make certain capital improvements to other facilities of the District to issue \$32,000,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum of 20 years; and collect excess property taxes annually to repay the bonds, as provided in Resolution #10-11-04. Should this proposition be:

On April 7, 2011, the Klickitat County Auditor mailed each qualified voter within the county a mail ballot, voting instructions, security envelope, and a pre-addressed envelope. Ballots will be counted only if returned in the return affidavit envelope, signed by the qualified voter and either postmarked no later than April 26, 2011, or received by the Klickitat County Auditor, Klickitat County Courthouse, 205 S. Columbus Ave., Room 203, Goldendale, WA or in one of the four drop boxes available 20 days prior to each election until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. The drop boxes are located in parking lots at the following locations: the corner of S. Columbus Ave. and W. Court St. in Goldendale, WA (north of the courthouse lawn); the Pioneer Center, 501 N.E. Washington St., White Salmon, WA (south end of the parking lot adjacent to the Post Office); the Dallesport Community Center, 136 6<sup>th</sup> St., Dallesport, WA; and the Lyle Lions Club, Intersection of 5<sup>th</sup> St. and State Hwy 14.

First class postage is required for returning a voted ballot by mail.

All signatures are subject to verification by the Klickitat County Canvassing Board or its duly authorized representatives.

If a mail ballot is destroyed, spoiled, lost or not received by the voter, replacement ballots may be obtained from the Klickitat County Auditor, Klickitat County Courthouse, Room 203, on or prior to April 26, 2011. On that day, such office will be open 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

For disabled persons and the visually impaired or for anyone wishing to vote on the electronic machine, an Accessible Voting Unit is available in the Klickitat County Auditor's Office from April 6, 2011 through April 26, 2011 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. with extended hours on April 26, 2011 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Special accommodations will be made for those that request it.
