PROPOSITION 1

BONDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW HIGH SCHOOL

The Board of Directors of Prosser Consolidated School District No. 116-219, adopted Resolution No. 12-10, concerning a proposition to finance construction of a new high school. This proposition would authorize the District to construct and equip a new high school on a site owned by the District adjacent to Art Fiker Stadium to replace Prosser High School; issue no more than \$41,355,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 12-10. SCHOOL MAINTENANCE & OPERATION LEVIES

The Board of Directors of Trout Lake School District No. 400-17 adopted Resolution No. 02-10, concerning a proposition to finance maintenance and operation expenses. This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, upon all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's General Fund educational maintenance and operation expenses:

On January 20, 2011, the Klickitat County Auditor mailed each qualified voter within the county a mail ballot, voting instructions, security envelope, and a pre-addressed

envelope. Ballots will be counted only if returned in the return affidavit envelope, signed by the qualified voter and either postmarked no later than February 8, 2011, or received by the Klickitat County Auditor, Klickitat County Courthouse, 205 S. Columbus Ave., Room 203, Goldendale, WA or in one of the four drop boxes available 20 days prior to each election until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. The drop boxes are located in parking lots at the following locations: the corner of S. Columbus Ave. and W. Court St. in Goldendale, WA (north of the courthouse lawn); the Pioneer Center, 501 N.E. Washington St., White Salmon, WA (south end of the parking lot adjacent to the Post Office); the Dallesport Community Center, 136 6th St., Dallesport, WA; and the Lyle Lions Club, Intersection of 5th St. and State Hwy 14.

First class postage is required for returning a voted ballot by mail.

All signatures are subject to verification by the Klickitat County Canvassing Board or its duly authorized representatives.

If a mail ballot is destroyed, spoiled, lost or not received by the voter, replacement ballots may be obtained from the Klickitat County Auditor, Klickitat County Courthouse, Room 203, on or prior to February 8, 2011. On that day, such office will be open 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

For disabled persons and the visually impaired or for anyone wishing to vote on the electronic machine, an Accessible Voting Unit is available in the Klickitat County Auditor's Office from January 19, 2011 through February 8, 2011 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. with extended hours on February 8, 2011 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Special accommodations will be made for those that request it.
