Proposition 1

M & O Levy Lid Lift

The Commission has adopted Resolution No. 461 concerning an increase in the District's regular property tax levy.

If approved, this proposition would provide funding for the operation, development and expansion of the District's health care facilities and services including the funding of an

electronic medical records system. It authorizes a maximum regular property levy rate in 2012 of \$0.35/\$1,000 assessed value (which is \$0.07 greater than the 2011 levy rate). The 2012 levy amount will be used to calculate subsequent levy limits in subsequent years. Should this proposition be:

On July 28, 2011, the Auditor will mail each qualified voter within the county a mail ballot. First class postage is required for returning a voted ballot by mail and must be postmarked by August 16, 2011. Ballots must be returned to our office or dropped into a designated drop box by 8:00 P.M. on August 16, 2011. Replacement ballots may be obtained in the Auditor's Office.

An Accessible Voting Unit is available in the Auditor's Office beginning July 27, 2011 through August 15, 2011 from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. with extended hours on August 16, 2011 from 7:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. Special accommodations will be made upon request.

The Logic and Accuracy Test will be held July 21, 2011. The public is invited to observe this test at 10:00 A.M. in the Auditor's Office.

The canvassing board, pursuant to 29A.60 RCW, will hold a public meeting at 9:30 A.M., August 23, 2011 to examine returns and at 9:30 A.M., August 31, 2011 in the Auditor's Office to certify the cumulative results, precinct results and a reconciliation report of the votes cast.
