On Monday October 31st, the Lewis County Canvassing Board shall convene at 9:00 a.m. at the Historic Courthouse, 351 NW North St, Chehalis to swear in the Canvassing Board Members. The clerks will then begin processing the returned ballots for the General Election to be held November 8, 2016. After removing all ballots from their designated envelope within each batch, they will then inspect, scan and resolve the ballots. These ballots will be secured at all times and results will be released after 8:00 p.m. on election night.
