## **NOTICE OF LOGIC AND ACCURACY TEST AND LEWIS COUNTY CANVASSING BOARD MEETINGS**

On Thursday, October 16<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m., a representative from the Office of the Secretary of State will be at the Lewis County Auditor's Office to observe the Logic and Accuracy Test conducted on the computer program for the November 4<sup>th</sup> State General Election. This test is open to the public to watch the proceedings.

On Monday, October 27<sup>th</sup>, the Lewis County Canvassing Board shall convene at 9:00 a.m., at the Lewis County Auditor's office to begin the canvass of the General Election to be held November 4, 2014. The first order of business will be to swear in all members and the clerks to the board. The clerks will then begin processing the returned ballots. After removing all ballots from their designated envelope, placing them with their respective precincts, they will then inspect, scan and resolve the ballots. These ballots will be secured until they are processed with the results released at 8:00 p.m. on election night. The canvassing board clerks will convene day to day, as needed, in order to complete the canvass not later than November 25, 2014. In addition, the canvassing board members shall meet on the following days, if needed, to resolve any questionable ballots and to certify the election; November 13<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 am, and November 25<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 am to certify the election.
