

# WHAT ARE THESE BAR CODES FOR?

The bar codes on the ballots are for tracking election date and precincts, as well as for making sure no ballot is counted more than once. The codes on the back of the page let the computer know it is the second page of the same ballot.

They are created in a separate system from the voter records and are NEVER traceable to individual voters.

If you have changed your permanent residence address, call this office to ensure the ballot you receive in future elections contains the races and issues for your resident address. Verifies for the Tally Computer that this ballot has not been copied or counted more than once.

**Election Code**  
Verifies to the Tally Computer that the ballot is for the correct election.
