

WHAT ARE THESE BAR CODES FOR?

The bar codes on the ballots are for verifying election date and precincts, as well as for making sure no ballot is counted more than once. The codes on the back of the page let the scanner know it is the second page of the same ballot.

Bar codes are created in a separate system from the voter records and are NOT traceable to individual voters.

Serial Number

Allows the scanning system to verify that this ballot has not been counted more than once.

Election Code

Verifies to the scanning system that the ballot is for the correct election.
