

Instructions


How to vote

Please use a black or blue ink pen to mark your choices on the ballot. To vote for your choice in each contest, completely fill in the box provided to the left of your choice. Secure your voted ballot in the white Security Envelope and place in the green Mailing Envelope. Sign and date the Affidavit on back. If your ballot is damaged to the point it is not useable, you may get a replacement by contacting the Election Office at: (509) 725-4971 or (800) 725-3031. If mailing, please affix first class postage or if you choose not to mail your ballot you may deliver it to: Lincoln County Auditor's Office, Lincoln County Courthouse, 450 Logan, Davenport or one of the designated drop boxes before 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. Lincoln County Public Hospital District No.1 Proposition No. 1 Replacement of Expiring One-Year Operation and Maintenance Levy The Commission of Public Hospital District No. 1, Lincoln County, adopted Resolution No. 111312.03 concerning a proposition to finance operation and maintenance expenses. This proposition would authorize the District to maintain current levels of essential health care services by levying excess property taxes, in place of an expiring levy, at the estimated levy rate of \$1.03 per \$1,000 of assessed value upon all taxable property within the District for collection in 2014 to provide a total of \$189,800 for paying part of the District's operation and maintenance expenses, all as provided in Resolution No. 111312.03.
