



REFERENDUM MEASURE NO. 71

The legislature passed Engrossed Second Substitute Senate Bill 5688 concerning rights and responsibilities of state-registered domestic partners and voters have filed a sufficient referendum petition on this bill. **Authorizing Regular Property  
Tax Levy Increase**

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Lincoln County Fire Protection District No. 7 adopted Resolution No. 09-01 concerning a proposition to authorize an increase for the regular property tax levy. This proposition would lift the lid on regular property tax levies as outlined in chapter 84.55 RCW, pursuant to RCW 84.55.050 and authorize the District to restore the regular property levy to \$1.00 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation from the current \$.85235 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation. This amount would be collected in 2010 and be used to compute the limitations for subsequent levies, subject to any otherwise applicable statutory dollar rate limitations.
