




Ballot Instructions:

If your ballot is damaged to the point it is not useable, you may get a replacement by contacting the Election Office at: (509) 725-4971 or (800) 725-3031. If you choose not to mail your ballot you may deliver it to: Lincoln County Auditor's Office, Lincoln County Courthouse, 450 Logan, Davenport or one of the designated drop boxes before 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Draw a line through the entire candidate's name like shown below. You then have the option of making another choice.

FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 7 PROPOSITION NO. 1
Authorizing Regular Property Tax Levy Increase

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Lincoln County Fire Protection District No. 7 adopted Resolution No. 08-01 concerning a proposition to authorize an increase for the regular property tax levy. This proposition would lift the lid on regular property tax levies as outlined in chapter 84.55 RCW, pursuant to RCW 84.55.050 and authorize the District to restore the regular property levy to \$1.00 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation for collection in 2009, which amount would be used to compute the limitations for subsequent levies, subject to any otherwise applicable statutory dollar rate limitations.

FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 8 PROPOSITION NO. 1

General Obligation Bonds - \$270,000

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Lincoln County Rural Fire Protection District No. 8 adopted Resolution 0832 concerning fire protection district facility bonds. This proposition authorizes Lincoln County Rural Fire Protection District No. 8 to acquire fire fighting vehicles and equipment to issue \$270,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum term of 12 years to finance such improvements, and to levy property taxes annually in excess of regular property tax levies to repay such bonds, provided in Resolution 0832.
