

NOTICE OF PRIMARY ELECTION

August 2, 2016

Lincoln County, Washington

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, August 2, 2016, in Lincoln County, State of Washington, there will be held a Primary Election, conducted all by mail Countywide. The purpose of this election is to nominate candidates to be voted for at the General Election, to be held on the Tuesday next succeeding the first Monday in November, 2016.

Registered voters residing in Lincoln County will be mailed a ballot on or about July 14, 2016. You may obtain a replacement ballot at the Lincoln County Auditor's office, 450 Logan, Davenport during regular business hours 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., or on Election Day 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

The last day for mail or online voter registrations and transfer of an existing registration to a new address will be Monday, July 4, 2016. The last day for in-person registration (for an individual who is eligible and is not currently registered in Washington State) is July 25, 2016 at the Lincoln County Auditor's Office, 450 Logan, Davenport, WA.
