

## **NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION**

**Notice is hereby given that** on Tuesday, February 12, 2019, in Lincoln County, State of Washington, with: Sprague School District No. 8J; Odessa School District No. 105, joint with Adams County No. 157 and Grant County No. 166; Harrington School District No. 204; Grand Coulee School District No. 301J ; Public Hospital District No. 1. There will be held a Special Levy Election, conducted all by mail. The purpose of this election is to approve and adopt or to reject a local school or special district proposition or bond.

**Registered voters residing in** the above mentioned districts will be mailed a ballot on or about January 23, 2019. You may obtain a replacement ballot at the Lincoln County Auditor's Office, 450 Logan, Davenport, WA during regular business hours 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. or on Election Day 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
