All voter registration applications, transfers from another county, changes of address within Mason County and other registration updates, submitted by mail or online, must be postmarked by Monday, July 9, 2012 or may be delivered to the Mason County Auditor's Office no later than 4:30 p.m., Monday, July 9, 2012 to be eligible for the August 7, 2012 Primary Election.

Persons not already registered in Washington State may register in-person no later than Monday, July 30, 2012 at the Mason County Auditor's Office, Monday thru Friday, 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. The Auditor's Office is closed from 12:30 p.m. – 1:30 p.m. daily.
