



Reconciliation Report Explanation

November 27, 2012

Total Ballots counted: 28,713

Credited voters: 28,712

Difference: 1

Issue: A voter returned a Federal Write In Absentee (FWAB) ballot, which was referred to canvass. The voter was registered and issued an UOCAVA ballot. The voter then returned the complete ballot; during processing it was mistakenly sent to canvass as a duplicate ballot. During reconciliation, it was recognized that it was not a duplicate ballot but should have been counted instead of the FWAB ballot.

Resolution: Because all the FWABs for the voter's precinct only had votes for the same 3 contests we were able to determine that the voter only voted for 3 contests on their FWAB ballot. We duplicated their remaining votes from the complete ballot on an additional ballot. The voter was only credited once but their choices were duplicated on two separate ballots.
