Notice of Logic and Accuracy Test

In accordance with RCW 29A.12.130, the Mason County Auditor's Office will conduct an official Logic and Accuracy Test for the General Election on Friday, October 2, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. The test will take place at the Mason County Auditor's Office, 411 N. 5th Street, Shelton. The purpose of the test is to verify the system will correctly count the votes cast for all candidates and all measures appearing on the ballot. Observers are welcome.

Notice of Ballots Mailed

Ballots for the November 3, 2009 General Election will be mailed to voters on October 16, 2009. Ballots to military and overseas voters will be mailed no later than October 4, 2009. Because Mason County votes entirely by mail, all active registered voters will automatically be mailed a ballot for the election.

Accessible Voting Equipment

Accessible voting equipment is available at the Auditor's Office during business hours beginning October 14, 2009 until 8:00 p.m. election night, November 3, 2009. The voting equipment is available to any voter wishing to use it, but the equipment has special features to allow voters with disabilities to vote independently.
